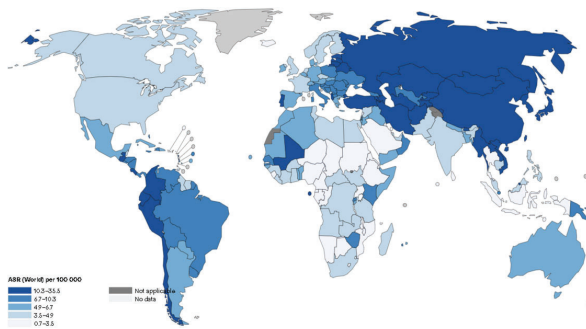
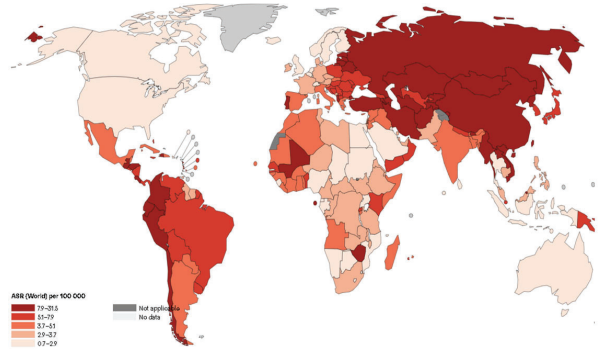

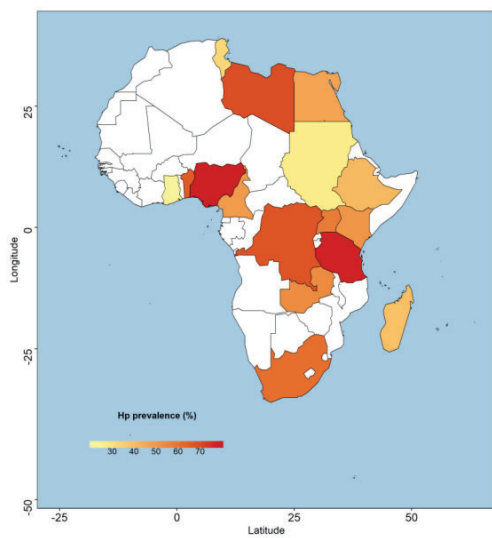


胃がんの死亡率

ピロリ菌感染率



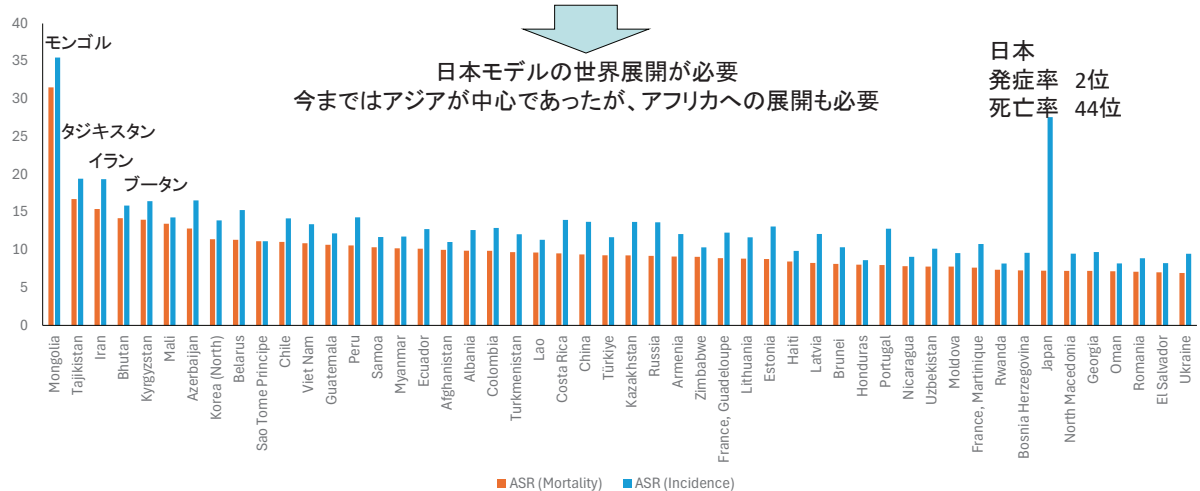
我々の未発表データでは、ピロリ菌感染率は非常に高い。
